ADDENDUM NOTIFICATION

It is notified that the following Physical Qualifications also are added as per GO (P) No. 16/2008/Tran Dtd 07/04/2008, to the Qualification insisted as item number 7 in the Notification for the post of **Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector** in the Motor Vehicles Department published under Category Number **245/2008** in the Gazette dated **11/07/2008**.

5. The candidates must be physically fit and shall possess the following minimum Physical Standards:

(a) Height : 165 cms for male candidates and 152 cms for female candidates.

(b) Chest : 81 cms with a minimum expansion of 5 cms (applicable to male candidates only)

Note:- For candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe, the minimum height shall be 160 cms for male candidates and 150 cms for female candidates.

(c) Visual Standards :

Must possess the visual standard specified below without glasses

1. Distant vision

Right eye

Left eye

6/6 Snellen

6/6 Snellen

2. Near vision

0.5 Snellen

0.5 Snellen

Note I :- (a) Each eye must have a full field of vision.

(b) colourblindness, Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eye shall be a disqualification for appointment.

Note II :- Candidates should produce a Medical Certificate (original) in the following format, obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon specialized in Ophthalmology of a Government Hospital when the Commission intimates :

Otherwise the certificate will not be accepted.

Note III :- Physically Handicapped candidates shall not be eligible for applying for the post.
