Any qualification in either of the above disciplines declared equivalent by the Central Government or State Government.

3. Working experience of at least 1 (one) year in a reputed (Government approved) automobile workshop which undertakes repairs of both Light Motor Vehicles, Heavy Goods Vehicles and Heavy Passenger Motor Vehicles fitted with Petrol and And Diesel Engines.

4. Must hold a driving licence authorizing him to drive Motor Cycle, heavy goods vehicles and heavy passenger motor vehicles.
