The above vacancy is now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and those that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age Limit : Must have completed 30 (thirty) years of age and must not have completed 45 (forty five) years of age as on 01.01.2008 .

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions).

7. Qualifications: -

1. A foreign going Masters Certificate granted by the Government of India or its equivalent with command experience for one year

OR

Must have served as an Officer not below the rank of Lieutenant Commander in the Indian Navy in the Executive Branch and must possess the certificate of service as Master (Foreign Going) and not being in the active list thereof.

Preferential :- Experience in piloting and/or dredging operation for one year or more.

2. Must be certified to possess the visual standard specified below:

1. Distant vision

Right eye Left eye

2. Near vision

Reads 0.6 Reads 0.6

3. Each eye must have a full field of vision.

4. Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or of the eyelids (trachoma like) of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification, but not colourblindness.

Note:- Candidates should produce a Medical Certificate (original) in the following format, obtained from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon, when the Commission intimates.

Note: (i) Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the certificate as given above, and vague statements such as Vision Normal etc. will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specifications are not as indicated above, the Officer issuing the certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision, as the case may be. Otherwise the certificate will not be accepted.

(ii) Probation :-Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(iii) Test :- Every person appointed to the post shall pass the following tests within the period of probation.

(i) Account Test for Executive Officers of the Kerala State and

(ii) Port Department Test (Higher Grade)
