**7. Qualifications :**

1. SSLC or equivalent qualification  
AND
2. (a) National Trade Certificate in the trade of Mechanic Refrigeration and Air Conditioning with 3 years experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate  
OR  
(b) National Apprenticeship certificate in the trade of Mechanic Refrigeration and Air Conditioning with one year experience in the trade after the certificate.  
OR  
(c) Diploma in Mechanical Engineering from a Government or Government recognized polytechnic or its equivalent qualification

Note (1) The experience gained by a workshop Attender in the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning trade can also be deemed as qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.

(2) Candidates belonging to SC/ST will be exempted from the qualifying experience prescribed in 2(a) and 2(b) above.

(3) The candidates should obtain the experience certificate from a recognized institution in the format given in Annexure and produce the same as and when required by the commission.

The application form which is a single sheet of paper specially designed for processing through Optical Mark Reader (OMR) also. Candidates have to fill up both sides of the application. Each application form contains a unique eight digit barcode on side 'A'. This barcode number is unique for each application. The candidate has to quote this number for further enquiries.

The cost of application form is Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten only). Cost of application for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidate is Rs.5/- (Rupees Five only). An information brochure will be supplied with the application form. Candidates should read the instructions carefully before filling up the form. Candidates should not enclose any documents along with the application.

Copies of documents to prove qualifications, date of birth and Community have to be produced as and when called for.
