5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age limit : Must have completed 19 (Nineteen) years and must not have completed 43 (Forty three) years of age as on 01.01.2008. Usual relaxation of age to SC/ST and OBC candidates shall be allowed.

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see para (2) of the General Conditions)

7. Qualifications:-

1 SSLC or its equivalent Qualification

And

2 (a) National Trade Certificate in the trade with 3 years experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.

OR

(b) National Apprenticeship Certificate in the trade with one year experience in the trade after obtaining the Certificate.

OR

(c) Diploma in concerned branch of Engineering from a Government or Government recognized Polytechnic or its equivalent qualification.

Note:- (1) The experience gained by a workshop attender in the trade can also be deemed to be qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.

(2) Candidates belonging to SC/ST will be exempted from the qualification of experience prescribed in 2 (a) and (b) above.

(3) The candidates should obtain the experience certificate from a Government recognized institution in the format given in Annexure and produce the same as and when required by the Commission.

8. Application:

The applications can be submitted by On-Line facility provided in the Website of the
Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of
applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission
viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the
application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Applications

which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

Candidates are allowed to submit the application in the conventional application form also.

The application form which is a single sheet of paper specially designed for processing through Optical Mark Reader (OMR) also. Candidates have to fill up both sides of the application. Each application form contains a unique eight Digit barcode on side 'A'. This barcode number is unique for each application. The candidate has to quote this number for further enquiries.

The application forms will be available in the Post Offices in the State and offices of the Kerala Public Service Commission.

The cost of application form is Rs.10/-(Rupees Ten) only. Cost of application for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala is Rs.5 (Rupees Five) only. An information brochure will be supplied with the application form. Candidates should read the instructions carefully before filling up the form. Copies of documents to prove qualification, date of birth and community have to be produced as and when called for.
