1. Department : Technical Education
2. Name of post : Lecturer in Civil Engineering (Engineering Colleges)
3. Scale of pay : Rs 8000 -13500 (Pre-Revised)
4. Number of vacancy : 3 (three)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked list published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and those that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment : Direct recruitment

6. Age Limit : Must have completed 20(Twenty) years of age and must not have completed 38 (thirty eight) years of age as on 01.01.2008, with usual relaxation to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward communities.

(For other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para 2 of the General Conditions).

Note:Officers of the Technical Education Department;Public Works Department ;Public Health Engineering Department ,Industries Department;Architecture and Town Planning Department may also apply and they will be allowed age relaxation to the extent of their service in those Department .Maximum age limit shall not exceed 50 years as on 1-1-08.A service certificate (in original) showing the length of their service should be produced as and when called for . Those who are eligible for age relaxation have to furnish the details in column 12 of the application form.

7. Qualifications:-

First class Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering /Technology.

OR

First class Masters degree in Civil Engineering/Technology.

Note 1:The percentage of marks obtained for the above mentioned examination should also be furnished in the column prescribed for noting qualification for the post,in the application .The term first class means "I class with a minimum of 60% aggregate marks"(G.O(P)No:6/2003/H.Edn dated 24.1.2003)

(2) Probation :Every person appointed to this post shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

(3)Liability to serve in Defence services :Persons appointed to the post shall be liable ,not withstanding that at the time of requisition they ,are holding higher appointments ,to serve for a minimum period of four years (including period spent in training)in the Defence services or on assignments relating to Defence efforts anywhere in India or abroad ,if so required The liability to serve in the Defence

Services will be limited to the first 10 years of service and will not ordinarily apply to persons above 40 years of age.

8. Applications should be submitted only by On-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz., www.Keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, experience, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. A recent passport size photograph should also be uploaded along with the application.
