The above vacancy is now in existence. 5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (From among Scheduled Caste Community only)

**NOTE:-** In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates, applications from Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered. The applications submitted by candidates belonging to Communities other than Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe Communities will be rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to them individually.

6. Age limit : Must have completed 24 (Twenty four) years and must not have completed 45 (Forty Five) years of age as on 01.01.2009. (including relaxation para 2(i) of General Conditions)  
(for conditions regarding the other age relaxation please see part (2) of the General Conditions except Para 2 (i).

**7. Qualifications:**

- (1) Post Graduate Degree (MDS) in Oral Pathology & Microbiology from a recognized University approved by the Dental Council of India.
- (2) State Dental Council Permanent Registration.

**NOTE:-** (1) Provisional Registration with any Dental Council will not be accepted.

(2) Candidates who have secured Permanent Registration with any other State/Central Dental Council will have to get themselves registered under the Travancore-Cochin Medical Practitioners Act before they join duty in the post.

8. **Application:-** The application should be submitted only through On-line facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. No application fee is required. The Barcode Number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community
