6. Age Limit : Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years and must not have completed 39 (Thirty nine) years of age as on 01.01.2009. (Including relaxation in Para 2 (i) of General Conditions)

7. Qualifications : 1(i) MSc. Degree I or II class in Physics from a recognised University.
- (ii) Successful completion of one year Postgraduate Training Course in Radiological Physics conducted by the Directorate of Radiation Protection of the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India.

- 2.(i)MSc. Radiation Physics from Calicut University with
(ii)RSO(Radiological Safety Officer) Level III certificate issued by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre after 3 weeks training and examination.

OR

3.(i)MSc. Medical Radiation Physics from Manipal Academy of Higher Education with
(ii)RSO level III certificate from Bhabha Atomic Research centre after 3 weeks training and examination.

OR

4.(i)MSc. Medical Physics from Anna University with
(ii)RSO Level III certificate from Bhabha Atomic Research centre after 3 weeks training and examination.
