7 Qualifications:-

- (1) A Pass in SSLC or its equivalent examination.
- (2) Must possess Survey Recorder Class I or Class II qualification of the Indian Naval Hydrographic Branch.

Note I :- (1) Candidate possessing Survey recorder Class I qualification must have an experience of not less than 4 years in Hydrographic Survey from the date of acquiring the Survey Recorder Class I qualification.

- (2) Candidates possessing Survey Recorder Class II qualification must have an experience of not less than 6 years in Hydrographic Survey from the date of acquiring the Survey Recorder Class II qualification.

Note II :- The candidates who do not have the experience mentioned above, can also apply for the post. However, the candidate so selected shall undergo training in the respective field for the required period. During the period of training, they shall be entitled to the full pay and allowances attached to the post.

Explanation I

Recognised Hydrographic Survey Service for the purpose of these rules may include the following:-

- 1 Service in the Hydrographic Department of the Indian Navy.
- 2 Service in the Hoogly River Survey Service.
- 3 Service in the Hydrographic Survey Wing of the Kerala State Port Department.
- 4 Service in the Hydrographic Survey Wing of the Ministry of Transport of the Government of India.
- 5 Service in the Hydrographic Organisation of Maritimes State of India.
- 6 Service in the Hydrographic Survey Department of the major ports of India.

Explanation II

Experience is the number of years of experience after acquiring the basic academic qualification.
