Note :- (i) Vacancies reported in writing from the schools under the control of Local Self Government Institutions shall also be filled up from the Ranked List prepared as per this notification.

(ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to them.

(iii) A Ranked List will be prepared for Thrissur district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above Community but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

(iv) Applications should be sent to Thrissur District only in response to this notification. Reservation Community candidates should submit application for the post to the concerned District Officer where the vacancy is existing for their respective community and should note the name of that district against the relevant column in side `B` of the application and darken the relevant bubble in side `A` of the OMR sheet. The address of the District Officer to which the applications are to be sent is furnished in column (11) of the notification.

(v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(Ms.) No. 154/71/PD., dated 27-5-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules laid down in G.O.(Ms.) No. 4/61/PD., dated 2-1-1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post.

5. Method of Appointment:

Direct Recruitment (Exclusively from among LC, OBC, Ezhava and Scheduled Caste reservation group of communities). In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates, the applications of Scheduled Tribe Candidates will also be considered.

6. Age limit:

Should have completed 18(Eighteen) years of age and should not have completed 42 (Forty two) in respect of LC, OBC, Ezhava communities and 44 (forty four) years of age in respect of Scheduled Caste as on 01.01.2009.

(Including the relaxation as per Para 2 (i) of General conditions.)

Note:-For concessions regarding age relaxation please see Para 2 of the general conditions except Para 2(i) subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (Fifty) years of age.

7. Qualificaitons :

1. A Degree in Arabic conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala

OR

A Title of Oriental Learning in Arabic awarded or recognized by the Universities in Kerala

OR

A Pass in SSLC Examination, Kerala or its equivalent and a pass in Arabic Munshi Examination (Higher) conducted by Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala

OR

(a) A pass in SSLC Examination, Kerala or its equivalent, and

(b) A Pass in Arabic Teachers Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

OR

Arabic Preliminary Examination of Kerala or Calicut Universities

OR

A Pass in Pre-Degree Examination in the Part III Arabic (Special Optional from the Calicut University).

8. Special Concessions Regarding Appointment and Age Limit:

1. Preference will be given as laid down in G.O(Ms)No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O(Ms)No.9/78/G.Edn. Dated 21.01.1978 to the Wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualification. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the term Jawans. Wives of Jawans should note on the top of side 'B' of the application form that they are Wives of Jawans. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates (true copies) from the officer commanding stating the name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when requested by the Commission (G.O(Ms) No.509/ 64/ Edn. dated 19.09.1964, G.O(Ms) No.614/ 65/ Edn. Dated 09.11.1965 and G.O(Ms) No.243/66/Edn. Dated 27.05.1966).

2. First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O(MS)No.122/75/G.Edn. Dated 27.05.75).

Note: - Candidates who claim concessions in lieu of any of the above reason should state the fact in the relevant column on side B and darken the bubble on the (OMR sheet) side A of application. Otherwise the applications are liable to be rejected presuming that they are over aged candidates.

9. Last date for receipt of applications: 15/07/2009 Wednesday up to 5 PM.

10. Application form and Application fee:

The application form is single sheet of paper printed on both sides to facilitate computer processing also using the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) . Side 'A' is OMR date sheet and Side 'B' is the conventional application form. Candidates must darken the bubbles on the side 'A' and fill up column on side 'B' of the application. Candidates must fill up both sides of the application. Each application form contains a unique eight digit barcode on side 'A'. This barcode is unique for each application. Candidates have to quote this number for further communication The cost of the application form is Rs.10/-(Rupees Ten only) The cost of application form for SC/ST candidates in Kerala is Rs. 5/-(Rupees Five only) The application should be filled in accordance with the directions contained in the information brochure supplied with the application. The application can be obtained from Post Offices in Kerala and Offices of the Commission.

- Note:-**
1. Documents to prove, qualification, age, community etc have to be produced as and when called for. No copies of documents should be attached with the application.
 2. Applications should be submitted in the form devised and printed by the KPSC and those applications submitted otherwise will be summarily rejected.

11. Address to which applications are to be sent : District Officer Concerned.

Applications sent to any address other than that of the K P S C District Officer, Thrissur will summarily be rejected

12. Mode of sending applications:
