The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list. Subject to the availability of admissible applications, not less than 15 candidates will be included in the Main list of the Shortlist with supplementary lists as per rules.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age limit : Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and must not have completed 36 (Thirty six) years of age as on 01.01.2009

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para 2 of the General Conditions)

Note: The Health Services Departmental hands will be given age relaxation to the extent of their service in the Department in order to enable them to apply for direct recruitment provided they are otherwise qualified.

7. Qualifications:-

- A. 1) Graduation from a recognised University
2) Diploma in Sociology, Social Service or Social Work (with Psychiatry as a special subject) awarded by a recognised University or Institution.
OR
- B. M.S.W. (Master's Degree in Social Work)
OR
- C. M.A. Sociology.

Note: In case candidates with M.S.W. or M.A. (Sociology) are selected, they will be sent for training for a period of 6 months to some institution which imparts training in Sociology, Social Service etc. on condition that they will serve Government for a minimum period of 5 years and necessary bond therefor executed

8. The applications should be submitted only through online facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to

prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected. A recent passport size photograph should also be uploaded along with the application.
