1. Department : Survey & Land Records
2. Name of post : Draftsman Grade 2
3. Scale of pay : Rs.6680-10790
4. Number of vacancies : Scheduled Tribe -3 (Three)

The above mentioned vacancies are now in existence. The ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the above vacancies earmarked for the above community but remains unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked list, published on 16.10.2004 for the post. 5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from among ST community only)

Note:- In the absence of ST candidates, SC candidates will also be considered. The application submitted by candidates belonging to communities other than mentioned above will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.

6. Age limit : Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and must not have completed (Forty) years of age as on 01.01.2009.

7. Qualifications

1. A pass in SSLC or its equivalent qualification.

2. Must have ITI (Surveyor Trade) Certificate introduced w.e.f. the year 1996

OR

Experience in Military service for a period of 6 years in Draftsman trade.

OR

The successful completion of Chain survey and Computer Draftsman Course conducted by the Survey Department under special assistance to special component plan 1983-84 shall be deemed as sufficient technical qualification for the post in the case of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates.

3. In the absence of candidates with the technical qualifications mentioned in (2) above, a pass in Chain Survey and Computer Draftsman Test shall be deemed sufficient.

4. In the absence of candidates with any of the technical qualifications mentioned above in 2 and 3, a pass in Chain Survey Test shall be deemed sufficient.
