Note :- (i) Vacancies reported in writing from the schools under the control of Local Self Government Institutions shall also be filled up from the Ranked List prepared as per this notification.

(ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to such candidates.

(iii) Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared for each district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against vacancies earmarked for the above communities but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following districts.

(iv) Applications should not be sent to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are sent contrary to the above direction, and if he is selected his name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him. Reservation community candidates should submit application for this post to the concerned District Officer where the vacancy is existing for their respective community and should note the name of that district against the relevant column in side `B` of the application and darken the relevant bubble in side `A` of the OMR sheet. The address of the District Officers to which the applications are to be sent is furnished in column (11) of the notification.

(v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(Ms.) No. 154/71/PD., dated 27-5-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(Ms.) No. 4/61/PD., dated 2-1-1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post.

5. Method of Appointment: Direct Recruitment.
(from the reservation group of communities mentioned above)

(In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates, the applications of Scheduled Tribe candidates will be considered and vice versa.

6. Age limit : Should have completed 18 (Eighteen) years and should not have completed 42 (Forty Two) years of age in respect of Ezhava, OX, Dheevara,SIUC Nadar/Anglo Indian, OBC, Viswakarma and Latin Catholic and 44 (Forty-four) years of age in respect of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Communities as on 1.1.2009 (Including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General Conditions).

Note:- For age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions under Part II of this notification subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall not exceed 50 (fifty) years, (except para 2 (i)).

7. Qualificaitons :

1) A Degree in Arabic conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala

OR

A Title of Oriental Learning in Arabic awarded or recognized by the Universities in Kerala .

OR

A pass in Pre-degree with Part III Arabic (Special Optional) of the Calicut University.

OR

A pass in SSLC Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala with Arabic under part I and II first Language.

OR

(A) A pass in SSLC Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations Kerala or its equivalent, and any one of the following qualifications.

(B) (1) A pass in Arabic Munshi Examination (Higher) conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examination, Kerala.

(2) A pass in Arabic Munshi Examination (Lower) conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

(3) A pass in Arabic Teachers Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

(4) A pass in Arabic Entrance Examination of the Kerala and Calicut Universities.

8. Special Concessions Regarding Appointment and Age Limit:

1. Preference will be given as laid down in G.O(Ms)No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O(Ms)No.9/78/G.Edn. dated 21.01.1978 to the Wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualification. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms Jawans. Wives of Jawans should note on the top of side 'B' of the application form that they are Wives of Jawans. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the officer commanding stating the name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission (G.O(Ms)No.509/64/Edn.dated19.09.1964, .O(Ms)No.614/65/Edn. dated 09.11.1965 and G.O(Ms)No.243/66/Edn.dated 27.05.1966).

2. First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O(MS)No.122/75/G.Edn. Dated 27.05.1975.

Note:- The candidates who claim concessions in lieu of any of the above reason should state the fact in the relevant column of Side B and darken the bubble in Side A of the application. Otherwise the applications are liable to be rejected presuming that they are over aged candidates.

10. Application form and Application fee

The application form is a single sheet of paper printed on both sides to facilitate computer processing also using the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) Side 'A' is OMR data sheet and Side 'B' is the conventional application form. Candidates must darken the bubble on the side 'A' and fill up columns in side 'B' of the application. Candidates must fill up both sides of the application. Each application form contains a unique eight digit barcode on side 'A'. This barcode is unique for each application. The Candidate has to quote this number for further communication. The cost of application form is Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only). The cost of the application form for SC/ST candidates of Kerala State is Rs. 5(Rupees Five only) The application should be filled in accordance with the directions contained in the information brochure supplied along

with the application. The application can be obtained from Post Offices in Kerala and Offices of the Commission.

Note:-1) Self attested copies of documents to prove qualification, age, community etc. should be produced as and when called for.

2) Applications should be submitted in the form devised and printed by the Kerala Public Service Commission and those applications submitted otherwise will be summarily rejected.

11. Address to which applications are to be sent: Concerned District Officers.

Applications sent to any address other than that of the District Officer to which the candidates apply will be summarily rejected.

12. Mode of sending applications :

(a) The name of the post, the category number and department of the respective post should be clearly noted at the top of the envelope.

(b) The name and address of the candidates shall be entered at the bottom left hand corner and the address to which applications are to be sent at the bottom right hand corner of the envelope.
