5. Method of appointment                      **Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among Scheduled Tribes only)**

**Note:-** Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6. Age limit    **Should have completed 18 (Eighteen) years and should not have completed 40 (Forty) years of age as on 01.01.2009. (No other age relaxation will be allowed)**

**Note:-** In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications:-    **B.Sc. Degree in Engineering (Civil) of Kerala University.**  
**OR**  
**B.E. Degree (Civil) of the Madras University or any other qualification recognized as equivalent there to.**  
**OR**  
**Bachelors degree in Architecture from any recognized institution or its equivalent.**  
**OR**  
**Associate Membership Diploma of the Institution of Engineers India in Civil Engineering or any other Diploma recognized as equivalent thereto.**  
**OR**  
**Pass in sections A and B of the Associate Membership Examination of the Institution of Engineers India in Civil Engineering.**
