1. Department : Kerala Higher Secondary Education
2. Name of Post : Higher Secondary School Teacher (Communicative English)
3. Scale of pay : Rs.11070-18450/-
4. Number of vacancy : 15 (Fifteen)

The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and those that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

NOTE: 3% of the vacancies are reserved for physically handicapped candidates.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6. Age limit : (1) Must have completed 20 (Twenty) years and must not have completed 39(Thirty nine) years of age as on 01.01.2009.(with usual relaxations of upper age limit to SC/ST and OBC candidates).

(For conditions regarding the age relaxations please see Para (2) of the General Conditions).

(2) Relaxation in upper age limit up to 42 years as on the first day of January 2009 shall be allowed to the qualified ministerial staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for direct recruitment to the category of Higher Secondary School Teacher mentioned above.

7. Qualifications :

I Master's Degree in Communicative English with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala.

M A English Language & Literature is not acceptable to this post. Hence individual rejection memo will not be issued to the candidates with this qualification.

II. (1) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala.

(2) In the absence of persons with B.Ed Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.

(3) In the absence of persons with B.Ed Degree as specified in items II (1) and (2) above, persons with B.Ed degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

III Must have passed the State Eligibility Test (SET) for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the agency authorized by the State Government.

NOTE:

(1) In the absence of B.Ed degree holders, candidates having Master's Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D Degree or M.Phil Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/ National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within 5 years from the date of entry in service.

(2) For selection to the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher in Communicative English, preference will be given to those who have acquired Post Graduate Diploma (not below B Grade) in teaching of English from Central Institute of English and Foreign Languages or M.Phil in English Language Teaching from a recognized University. Higher Secondary School Teacher in Communicative English must be capable of handling both English and Communicative English subjects.

(3) Those who have passed Language Teacher Training course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed qualification.

(4) Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the subject concerned recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.

EXEMPTIONS

(1) Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.

(2) Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/ Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.

(3) Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed Degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

(4) The teachers who have completed ten years of approved teaching service at the High School Level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teacher.

8. Method of submitting application:

The application can be submitted only by on-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission [Viz.www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
