Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared and published for each subject mentioned in para 2 above. The lists of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year that the said lists will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said lists against the vacancies noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the lists.

- 5 Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment.  
6 Age Limit : (i) Must have completed 20 (Twenty) years of age and must not have completed 39 (Thirty nine) years of age as on 01.01.2009 with usual relaxation to SC/ST and OBC candidates (for conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Part II of the General Conditions )  
(ii) Relaxation in upper age limit upto 42 years as on the first day of January 2009 shall be allowed to the qualified Ministerial Staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for Direct Recruitment to the Category of Higher Secondary School Teacher.

7. Qualifications:-

1. Kannada

(i) Master's degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala

(ii) (1) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala

(2) In the absence of persons with B.Ed degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala

(3) In the absence of persons with B.Ed degree as specified in items (1) and (2) above, persons with B.Ed degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala

(iii) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the Agency authorised by the State Government.

**Note:** (1) In the absence of B.Ed Degree holders, candidates having Masters Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have Passed State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired PhD Degree or M.Phil Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed degree at their own expense within 5 years from the date of entry in service.

(2) Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed. qualification.

(3) Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the subject concerned recognised by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.

**2. Psychology** (i) Master's degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala

(ii) (1) B.Ed in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala

(2) In the absence of persons with B.Ed degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala

(3) In the absence of persons with B.Ed degree as specified in items (1) and (2) above, persons with B.Ed degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognised as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala

(iii) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the Agency authorised by the State Government.

**Note : 1-** Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the subject concerned recognised by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.

**Exemptions for the two posts**

1. Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test for post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
2. Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
3. Persons with P.hD/M.Phil/M.Ed Degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognised as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala
4. The Teachers who have completed Ten years of approved Teaching Service at the High School level in the General Education Subordinate Service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teacher.

**Note:** Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) means Part Time post of Higher Secondary School Teacher.

**8. Mode of submitting applications**

Applications should be submitted only by on-line facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz., [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Application which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
