The above vacancy is now in existence. A probability list/short list will be prepared as part of the selection process by including not less than 10 candidates (if available) in the Main List with necessary Supplementary List. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancy noted above and those that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment

6. Age Limit: Must have completed 18 (eighteen) years of age and must have completed 35 (thirty five) years of age as on 01.01.2009 with usual relaxation to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward communities.

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions).

7. Qualifications: -

(1) A Pass in S. S. L. C or equivalent Examination or a pass in the educational Test of the Indian Navy.

(2) Must possess Survey Recorder class II qualification of the Hydrographic Survey Branch of the Indian Navy or Diploma in Civil Engineering issued by the Government of Kerala or any recognized Board of Public Examination.

Preferential:

Experience in reputed drawing office preferably connected with Chart Drawing.

The following Institutions are competent to issue the experience certificate in chart Drawing:

1. Hydrographic Service of the Indian Navy.
2. Hydrographic Survey Wing of the Government of Kerala.
3. Survey Organization of the Ministry Of Transport, Government of India.
4. Hydrographic Survey Organization of the Maritime states in India.
5. Hydrographic Survey Organization of the Major Ports in India.

Note:

The Experience qualification shall be one gained after acquiring the basic Academic qualification. The experience qualification shall not be insisted in the Case

of SC/ST candidates. The candidates so selected shall acquire the required experience qualification after recruitment.

**8. Probation:-** Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of 2 years within a continuous period of 3 years.

**9.** Candidates are allowed to submit the application by online only. ( Documents to prove qualification, age, experience and community have to be produced as and when called for.)
