As per the availability of qualified candidates, a Shortlist/Ranklist containing not less than 10 candidates will be published.

The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked List published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and those that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment

6. Age Limit: Must have completed 20 (Twenty) years of age and must not have completed 40(Forty) years of age as on 01.01.2010 with usual relaxation to SC/ST and OBC candidates.

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para 2 of the General Conditions).

7. Qualifications: - 1. Degree in Architecture (B.Arch) or any other qualification recognised by Government as equivalent there to with not less than 60% marks in the qualifying examination.

2.Eight years experience in architecture of which at least three years should be teaching experience in the subject as lecturer not below diploma level in recognised /approved institution.

Note -I) Diploma in architecture obtained after under going a regular course of study for not less than 3 years with 60%marks in the qualifying examinations and a pass in section A and B of AMIE will be considered as equivalent to degree in architecture.

ii) In the case of first or second class Post Graduate degree holders in Architecture the prescribed 60% marks in the concerned branch for the basic degree will not be insisted upon.

The total marks of all the years/semesters of the course in which University Examinations are conducted shall be taken into account in calculating the 60% marks

iii) Percentage of marks obtained for the above mentioned examinations, details of experience & name of the branch of the course should be furnished in the column prescribed for noting qualification for the post in the application form.

iv) Experience claimed by the candidates shall be the one gained after acquiring the basic qualification for the post. [Candidates should produce experience certificate in the format appended below.] (Please see next page.)

v) The veracity of the Experience Certificate will be subjected to scrutiny and those who issue or produce bogus certificate will be subjected to legal proceedings. The experience certificate obtained from private institutions shall be got countersigned by an authorized officer of the state/central Govt.

8. Applications should be submitted only by On-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission.
