The above vacancy is now in existence. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancy noted above and the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list. A Short List/Probability list will be prepared as part of the selection process by including not less than 10 (Ten) candidates (if available) in the Main List with necessary Supplementary Lists.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age limit : Must have completed 19 (Nineteen) years of age and must not have completed 43 (Forty three) years of age, as on 01.01.2010 with usual relaxation of age to SC/ST and OBC candidates.

(For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para (2) of the General Conditions).

7. Qualifications:

1. Pass in SSLC or its equivalent qualification.
AND
- 2 (a) National Trade Certificate in the particular trade with three years experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.
OR
- (b) National Apprenticeship Certificate in the trade with one year experience after obtaining the certificate.
OR
- (c) Diploma in the concerned branch of Engineering from a Government or Government recognised Polytechnic or its equivalent qualification.

Note:- (i) The experience gained by a Workshop Attender in the trade can also be deemed to be qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.

(ii) Candidates belonging to SC/ST shall be exempted from the qualification of experience prescribed for direct recruitment.

(iii) The candidates should obtain the Experience Certificate from a Government recognised institution in the format given in Annexure and produce the same as and when required by the Commission.
