The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked List published by the Commission in pursuance of this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies noted above and also against the vacancies, if any, reported to the Commission in writing during the period of the currency of the list.

3% vacancies of the post shall be reserved for PH candidates belonging to the category of Orthopaedically Handicapped, Visually Impaired, Low Vision and Partially Deaf and hearing impaired vide GO(P)No. 119/2005/SWD dated 06.08.2005.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment
6. Age Limit : Must have completed 20 (Twenty) years and must not have completed 39 (Thirty nine) years of age as on 1.1.2010 with usual relaxation in upper age limit to SC/ST/OBC classes [for conditions regarding age relaxations, please see Para 2 of the General conditions].
 - (i) Relaxation in upper age limit upto 42 (Forty two) years as on the first day of January 2010 shall be allowed to the qualified Ministerial Staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for Direct Recruitment to the category of Higher Secondary School Teacher.

7. Qualifications : Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala.

 - 1) B.Ed. in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala.
 - 2) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed. degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.
 - 3) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. degree as specified in item (1) and (2) above, persons with B.Ed. degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
 - (iii) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by the Government of Kerala or by the Agency authorized by the State Government.

Note:- In the absence of BEd. degree holders, candidates having Masters Degree with

- (1) not less than 50% marks and who have passed State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired PhD Degree or MPhil. Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire BEd. degree at their own expense within 5 years from the date of entry in service.
- (2) Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring BEd. qualification.
- (3) Persons who have acquired MEd. In the subject concerned recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from BEd. qualification.

Exemptions for the Post

1. Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test for post of College Lecturers conducted by the Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
 2. Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
 3. Persons with PhD/MPhil/MEd. Degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the MPhil. in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
 4. The teachers who have completed ten years of approved Teaching Service at the High School level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teacher.
