The above vacancies are now in existence. Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared and published for each subject mentioned above. The Ranked Lists published in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of new lists after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of the 3 years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said lists against the vacancies noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the lists. Subject to the availability of qualified, candidates the number of candidates that may be included in the Short List will be decided later by the Commission.

Note:- 3% of the vacancies are reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates as per G.O.(P)No.43/2009/SWD dated, 13.10.2009.

5. Method of appointment : Direct recruitment
6. Age limit : 1. Must have completed 20 (Twenty years) and must not have completed 39 (thirty nine) years of age as on 01.01.2010 with usual relaxations to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward communities.
- (For conditions regarding the age relaxations please see para (2) of the General Conditions)
2. Relaxation in upper age limit upto 42 years as on the first day of January 2010 shall be allowed to the qualified ministerial Staff under Higher Secondary Education Department for direct recruitment to the above categories of Higher Secondary School Teacher.

7. Qualifications:-

Sl.No. 1 (Computer Science/Computer Application)

1. Master's degree in Engineering or Technology in the concerned subject/M.Tech. Degree in Computer Science, Computer Engineering or Information Technology/Software Engineering with not less than 50% marks from a recognized University.

OR

Master's degree in Computer Application/ Master's degree in Computer Science or Information Technology with not less than 50% marks from a recognized University.

2. In the absence of qualified candidates in item (1) above, B.Tech/Bachelor of Engineering Degree with not less than 50% marks in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering/Information Technology from a recognized University.

OR

B.Tech/Bachelor of Engineering Degree with not less than 50% marks in any branch of study with post-graduate Diploma in Computer Application from a recognized University or

Lal Bahadur Sastri Centre for Science and Technology/Institute of Human resource development or Department of Electronics 'A' level accredited.

OR

Master's Degree with not less than 50% marks in Mathematics/Physics with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application from a recognized University/Lal Bahadur Sastri Centre for Science and Technology/Institute of Human resource development or Department of Electronics 'A' level accredited.

OR

M.Tech. Degree with not less than 50% marks in Electronics and Telecommunication/ Electronics Engineering from a recognized university.

OR

B.Sc. degree in Computer Science with not less than 50% marks and Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications from a recognized University or Lal Bahadur Sastri Centre for Science and Technology/Institute of Human Resource Development or Department of Electronics 'A' level accredited.

OR

M.Sc. Statistics with not less than 50% marks with PGDCA from a recognized University.

Sl.No.2 (Electronics)

1. Masters degree in Electronics/M.Tech in Electronics or Electronics and Communication with not less than 50% marks from a recognized University.

OR

B.Sc. (Engineering) or B.Tech. or B.E. degree in Electronics/Electronics and Communications/Electronics and instrumentation/Electrical and Electronics with not less than 50% marks from a recognized University.

2. In the absence of qualified hands under item (1) above B.Sc. degree in Electronics or B.Sc. Computer Science with not less than 50% marks and pass in MCA from a recognised University.

8. Mode of submitting Applications:

The Applications can be submitted only by on-line facility provided in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz.www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. The applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the Website will be summarily rejected.
