6. Age limit : Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and must not have completed 35 (Thirty five) years of age as on 01.01.2010 with usual relaxation to SC,ST and OBC.

7. Qualifications:-

- (i) General: Completion of the course of study for Pre-University or Pre-Degree examination of a recognised University or any equivalent qualification.
- (ii) Technical: (a) Successful completion of Medical Laboratory Technicians Course of the Medical Colleges of Kerala.
OR
(b) Successful completion of the Blood Transfusion Assistant Class 3 and class 2 courses of the Army Medical Corps.
