Note: (i) Vacancies reported in writing from the schools under the control of Local Self Government Institutions shall also be filled up from the Ranked List prepared as per this notification.

(ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will issued to them.

(iii) Separate Ranked List will be prepared for Kannur district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above Community but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post.

(iv) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS)No.154/71/PD, dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O.(Ms)No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (in the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates, the applications of Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered).

6. Age Limit: Should have completed 18 (Eighteen) years and should not have completed 44 (Forty four) years of age as on 01.01.2010 (Including the relaxation as per para 2(i) of General Conditions.)

Note:- For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the General Conditions under part II except para 2(i) subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications:

A Degree in Urdu and B.Ed/B.T/L.T conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala

OR

A Title of Oriental learning in Urdu awarded or recognized by the Universities in Kerala (if such title has been declared as equivalent to Part III of degree) and Certificate in Language Teacher's Training issued by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

Note:- (1) Candidates possessing Post Graduate Degree in Urdu are also eligible to apply for the post provided they have the required training qualification (GO(MS)177/87/G.Edn. dated 22.08.87)

(2) B.Ed should also be in the concerned language.

8. Special Concessions Regarding Appointment and Age Limit:

1. Preference will be given as laid down in G.O.(Ms)No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O.(Ms)No.978/G.Edn. dated 21.01.1978 to the Wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualification. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans. Such facts should be noted in the space provided for in the online application form. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the officer commanding stating the name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission (G.O.(Ms)No.509/64/Edn. Dated 19.09.1964, G.O.(Ms)No.614/65/Edn. Dated 09.11.1965 and G.O.(Ms)No.243/66/Edn. Dated 27.05.1966).
2. First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O.(Ms)No.122/75/G.Edn. dated 27.05.1975).
3. Teachers of the Government Primary and Nursery Schools who are Graduates and are otherwise qualified will be exempted from upper age limit (G.O.MS.No. 185/70/Edn. Dated 18.04.70 and G.O.MS.No.466/70/Edn. Dated 11.11.70). They should produce proper certificates from authorities concerned, as and when required by the Commission.

9. Application Form:

Applications should be submitted only through on-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The application forms of the PSC designed for processing through Optical Mark Reader will not be considered for this post. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org) No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form from the Website shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Application which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
