Selection will be made on Battalion-wise basis. Candidates appointed to the various Battalions will be allowed transfer only to the concerned District Armed Reserves as shown against the Battalions noted above.

Note: 1. Candidates are prohibited from applying to more than one Battalion in response to the notification. Name of the Battalion chosen should clearly be shown in application form.

2. Separate ranked lists for each Battalion will be published. The Ranked List thus published shall cease to be in force after one year from the date of finalization of the ranked list or after one month from the date of commencement of training in respect of the last batch advised from the ranked list within a period of one year from the date of finalization of the Ranked List which ever is later. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the Ranked List.

5) Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (Battalion wise)

6) Age Limit 18-25 : Only candidates born between 2.1.1985 and 1.1.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

Note: (i) The upper age limit for OBC and SC/ST candidates are relaxed as follows. Candidates belonging to Other Backward Communities born on or after 2.1.1982 and candidates belonging to SC/ST born on or after 2.1.1980 are eligible to apply for this post.

(ii) Other conditions regarding age relaxation in Para (2) of the General Conditions are not applicable to this selection.

(iii) Physically Handicapped persons are not eligible to apply in response to this Notification.

7) Qualification:

(a) Educational
Pass in HSE (Plus 2) or its equivalent.

(b) Physical Qualifications:

(i) Height : 157 CM

Note: Minimum Height shall be 150 CMs for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes candidates.

(ii) Eye Sight : Must be certified to possess the visual standards specified below without glasses.

Vision	Right Eye	Left Eye
a. Distant Vision	6/6 Snellen	6/6 Snellen
b. Near Vision	0.5 Snellen	0.5 Snellen

Note: 1. Each Eye must have a full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid conditions of the Eye or lids of either eye will be deemed to be a disqualification.

2. Must be free from apparent physical defects like Knock-knee, Flat foot, Varicose vein, Bowlegs, Deformed limbs, Irregular and Protruding tooth, Defective speech and hearing.

3. Must qualify in any five events out of eight events specified below of the National Physical Efficiency, One Star Standard Test.

Note: - The height of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed height will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. While participating in the Physical Efficiency Test, if accidents or injuries happen to a candidate she will not be allowed further chance to participate in the test.

The candidates should produce at the time of physical efficiency test, a Medical Certificate in original in the form prescribed hereunder certifying to their physical fitness and eye sight without glasses. The Medical Certificate should be one obtained from a Medical Officer under the Government not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.

Note: Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the Certificate as given above and vague statement such as Vision 'Normal' etc will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specifications are not as indicated above, the officers issuing the Certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standard of vision as the case may be, otherwise the Certificate will not be accepted.

Applications should be submitted only through On-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The application forms of the PSC designed for processing through Optical Mark Reader will not be considered for this post. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz., www.keralapsc.org No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
