1. Department : Port
2. Name of Post : Seaman (Special Recruitment for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe)
3. Scale of Pay : Rs.5250- 8390
4. Number of vacancies: Districtwise Kozhikode—3 (Three)

Note:- i) The list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from SC/ST during the pendency of the list. Candidates against vacancies reported exclusively for Scheduled Tribes will also be advised from this list and only in the absence of Scheduled Tribe candidates in this list that fresh notification for vacancies reserved exclusively for Scheduled Tribes will be issued.

ii) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(Ms) No.154/71/PD dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the ranked list prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five (5) years, it will be subject to the rules contained in G.O.(Ms) No.4/61/PD dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding this post in any one district are restricted from applying for the same post in another District. But they can apply for higher posts.

iii) The name of the district Kozhikode should be noted in the relevant column of the application.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from among Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes only).

Note:- Applications received from non Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communication regarding rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6. Age Limit : 18-40. Only candidates born between 02.01.1970 and 01.01.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post (No other age relaxation will be allowed).

Note:- In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications :-

1. Must have studied upto Standard VIII.

2. Proficiency in boat pulling, knots, splices and rigging, Handling single cylinder motor boats, anchor work and swimming. The proficiency in the above items of work shall be assessed in a practical test conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission at the time of selection.

Note:- In making selection, Preference as coming with the meaning of G.O.(MS) No.50/70/PD dated 12.2.1970 as amended by G.O.(MS)No 246/70/PD 21.07.1970 shall be given to candidate who had undergone Seaman training successfully in the Kerala Institute of Nautical Studies, Vizhinjam or similar other training institutions.

3. They shall possess the physical standards specified below.
Height : Not less than 165 Cms (without shoes or boots)

Weight : Not less than 50 Kgs.

Chest : Not less than 80 Cms. Normal and Not less than 85 Cms on Expansion

4. Vision	Right eye	Left eye
Distant Vision	6/6	6/6
Near Vision	0.6	0.6

Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or eyelids (eg.trachoma) will be deemed as a disqualification.

8) Application Form:-

Applications should be submitted only through On-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The application forms of the PSC designed for processing through Optical Mark Reader will not be considered for this post. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz., www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

9. Last Date for receipt of applications : 21/07/2010 Wednesday upto 5.00 p.m.

11. Paragraphs two, three and twenty seven (except the conditions laid down in the Rule 3(c) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules) are not applicable to this selection.

12. Appointments are made subject to the rank secured in the Ranked List of candidates prepared in pursuance of this notification subject to the conditions laid down in G.O.MS.No.142/72/PD dated, 13.04.1972, G.O.MS No.309/73/PD dated, 29.11.1973, G.O.(P)No.21/76/PD dated, 17.01.1976 and G.O.(P) No.25/94/GAD dated, 22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled caste and Scheduled Tribes in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under Sections 3(c), 17(a), 17(b) of Part II of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
