- 1 Name of the firm : Kerala Municipal Common Service
- 2 Name of Post : Driver Grade II (HDV)

- 4 Number of vacancies : 26 (Twenty Six)

The above vacancies are now in existence. Number of candidates to be included in the Probability List/Short List will be decided later according to the availability of the qualified candidates. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the list will not continue to be in force if a new Ranked List after the minimum period of one year is published. Candidates will be advised against the vacancies shown above and for all the vacancies reported during the period of pendency of the Ranked List.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6. Age : 18-35.

Only candidates born between 2.1.1975 and 1.1.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. Other Backward Communities and SC/ST candidates are eligible for usual age relaxation.

NOTE:- The provisional hands working in the above concern will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of Five years from the upper age limit provided they are within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the above concern and also provided they possess a minimum service of one year in the provisional appointment. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It should also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern (for other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see Para 2 (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (vi) & (xii) of the general conditions).

7. Qualifications:

- 1 Literacy in Malayalam, Tamil or Kannada
- 2 Must Possess Motor Driving License of at least 3 years standing with endorsement for driving Heavy Duty Vehicles.
- 3 Proficiency in driving Heavy Duty Vehicels (to be proved at practical test)
- 4 Medical fitness.
 - a. Ear:- Hearing should be perfect
 - b. Eye:- Distant vision - 6/6 snellen
Near Vision - 0.5 snellen
Colour vision- Normal
Night Blindness -Nil
 - c. Muscles and Joints - No Paralysis and all joints with free movements
 - d. Nervous System - Perfectly normal and free from all infectious diseases.

Note:

1. The Medical Certificate (in original) issued in the prescribed form by a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon regarding the Physical fitness and a Medical Certificate regarding vision from an ophthalmologist in Government Service in the prescribed format must be produced as and when called for by the Commission. The prescribed form of medical certificates are given below.
2. Physically Handicapped persons are not eligible to apply for this post.
3. Candidates should posses current Driving License on the last date for receipt of applications in this Office and also on the date of written test/practical

test/interview.
4. The proficiency to drive Heavy Duty Vehicles will be assessed by conducting a practical test. An H Test will also be conducted at any stage found suitable by the Commission.

8 The application can be submitted only by online facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instruction regarding the submission of the applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The candidates applying through online should keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community etc have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instruction given in the website will be summarily rejected.

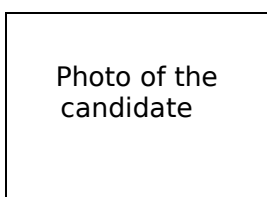

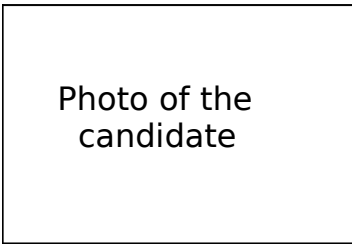
