Note:- (1) Conventional type application for the above post will be summarily rejected. Candidates can apply only through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website.

(2) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.

(3) Separate Ranked list will be prepared for each districts in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against all the NCA turns identified as unfilled during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following districts.

(4) Applications should not be sent for more than one district in response this notification. If applications are sent contrary to the above direction and if he/she is selected his/her name will be removed from the ranked lists and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her. Reservation Community candidates should opt the applications for this post to the concerned District Office where the vacancy is existing for their respective community and should note the name of that District against the relevant Column. The address to which applications are to be sent is given in column 10 of the Notification.

5. The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No.4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5.Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (Candidates belonging to SIUC/AI.,LC, Muslim and Dheevara community only.

6.Age :18-43. Only candidates born between 02.1.1967 and 01.01.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

7. Qualifications:

(1) General:- Pass in SSLC or its equivalent qualification.

(2) Technical:- a) Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery Certificate (Revised Course of 18 months duration) issued by the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

OR

Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery Certificate/Auxiliary Nurse Midwifery Certificate (Revised Course) issued by an authority recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.

Note: Health Workers Training Certificate issued by the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council will also be accepted in lieu of the above technical qualification.

b) Registration with the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council.

Note: (i) In the absence of candidates possessing the General qualification viz.SSLC pass, candidates who have completed SSLC Course(SSLC failed candidates) will also be considered.

(ii) Physically handicapped candidates are not eligible to apply for this post.

8. Mode of sending applications:

The applications should be submitted only through online facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The candidates applying through on-line should keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age and community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
