6 Age : (19-43) Only Candidates born between 02.01.1967 and 01.01.1991 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post. Relaxation of age will be allowed to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC.

7. Qualifications : -

1. Pass in SSLC or its equivalent qualification.

AND

2. (a) National Trade Certificate in the particular trade with three years experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.

OR

(b) National Apprenticeship Certificate in the trade with one year's experience in the trade after obtaining the certificate.

OR

(c) Diploma in the appropriate branch of Engineering from a Government or Government Recognized Polytechnic or its equivalent qualification.

Note:- (i) The experience gained by a Workshop Attender in the trade can also be deemed to be qualifying experience in the trade for selection to this post.

(ii) Candidates belonging to SC/ST shall be exempted from the qualification of experience prescribed for direct recruitment.

(iii) The certificate to be produced in proof of experience shall be in the form given below.
