1. Department : Ayurveda Colleges
2. Name of Post : Nurse Grade II (Ayurveda) (Special Recruitment from Scheduled Tribes only)
3. Scale of Pay : Rs. 6080-9830
4. No. of vacancies : District wise Kannur-1 (One)

Note: 1) The above vacancy is now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment for Scheduled Tribes only during the pendency of the list.

2) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis subject to the Special Conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No. 154/71/PD, dated: 27-05-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List so prepared is not eligible for transfer to another District unless he/she completes five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former District. Even if, transfer is allowed after five (5) years, it will be subject to the orders contained in G.O.(MS) No. 4/61/PD, dated: 2-1-1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the post in One District are restricted from applying for the same post in another District. But they can apply for higher posts.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among Scheduled Tribes only)

Note:- Applications received from non Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason won't be issued.

6. Age : (19-40) Only candidates born between 02-01-1970 and 01-01-1991 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this Post. (No other age relaxation will be allowed).

Note:-In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications:

- (i) Pass in SSLC or equivalent examination
- (ii) Certificate in Ayurveda Nurses Course recognized by the Government of Kerala

8. Application Form:

The applications should be submitted only through On-line facility provided in the Website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number obtained after submission of the application (from the website) shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondences. Documents to prove Qualification, Age, and Community have to be produced as and when called for. Application submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled Tribes, and in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under sections 3(c), 17 (a), 17(b) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
