2. Name of Post : Full Time Junior Language Teacher (Arabic)UPS

Note:- (i) Vacancies reported in writing from the schools under the control of Local Self Government Institutions shall also be filled up from the ranked lists prepared as per this notification.

(ii) Conventional type applications for the above post will be summarily rejected. Candidates can apply through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website.

(iii) Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared for each District in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked lists thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the original Ranked lists published for the post in the following districts.

(iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (Ms.) No. 154/71/PD. Dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O. (Ms.) No. 4/61/PD. dated 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one District are prohibited from applying again for this post.

- (5) Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (from above mentioned reservation group of communities).

In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates, candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe will also be considered.

- (6) Age Limit : Should have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and should not have completed 42(Forty Two) and 44 (Forty-four) years of age in respect of OX and Scheduled Caste Communities respectively as on 01.01.2010. (Including the age relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General conditions).

Note: - For concessions regarding other age relaxation, please see para 2 of the general conditions except para 2 (i)

(7) Qualifications:

A Degree in Arabic conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A Title of Oriental Learning in Arabic awarded or recognized by the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A pass in SSLC Examination, Kerala or its equivalent and a pass in Arabic Munshi Examination (Higher) conducted by Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

OR

- (a) A pass in SSLC Examination, Kerala or its equivalent, and
(b) A Pass in Arabic Teachers Examination conducted by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

OR

Arabic Preliminary Examinations of Kerala or Calicut Universities.

OR

A Pass in Pre-Degree Examination in the Part III
Arabic (Special Optional) from the Calicut University

8. SPECIAL CONCESSIONS REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND AGE LIMIT

- Preference will be given as laid down in GO(MS)No.50/70/PD dated 12.2.1970 and
1. G.O(MS)No. 9/78/G.Edn. Dated 21.01.1978 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans. Wives of Jawans must select "Are you entitled to any priority" as 'Yes' on online application and give the details in the following space. This benefit will not be available to those candidates who do not state the aforesaid details in that manner, even if they produce relevant later. (G.O.(MS) No.509/ 64/Edn. dated19.09.1964, G.O.(MS) No.614/65/Edn. dated 09.11.1965 and G.O.(MS) No.243/66/Edn. dated 27.05.1966).
 2. First class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O.M.S)No.122/ 75/G.Edn. dated 27.05.1975).

Note: The candidates who claim concessions in lieu of any of the above reasons should select "Are you eligible for age relaxation" as 'Yes' on the online application and give details in the following space.

Documents to prove qualifications, age and community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instruction given in the website will be summarily rejected.
