3) Reservation community Candidates should submit application for this post to the District Officer, Kasaragod where the vacancy is existing for Ezhava community.

4. The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No.154/71/PD dated 27.5.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue district from the ranked list prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after 5 years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O. (MS) No. 4/61/PD dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (for Ezhava community only)

6. Age Limit : Should have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and should not have completed 38 (Thirty eight) years of age as on 01.01.2010.

OR

A pass in the Laboratory Technician Course for a period of 1 year conducted by the Dean, Madras Veterinary College, Madras.

OR

Class I Laboratory Assistant from Armed Forces Medical College having 15 years experience in the Army Trade of Laboratory Assistant Class 1

OR

Ex-servicemen having 16 years of experience in the Army Trade of Laboratory Assistant Class 1

OR

Job oriented Pre-University Diploma in HE 1- 01 Laboratory Technician awarded by Government of Karnataka, State Council of Vocational Education.

OR

Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology awarded by the Punjab State Medical Faculty.

OR

A pass in VHSE in Medical Laboratory Technician
