1. Name of concern : Kerala State Co-operative Bank Ltd.
2. Name of Post : Accounts Officer
3. Scale of Pay : Rs. 10975 - 29300
4. No. of vacancy : 2 (Two)

Note:- (1) The above vacancies are arrived at by dividing the 4 vacancies reported from Kerala State Co-operative Bank Ltd, in the proportion of 1:1 ratio between General Category (Part I) and Society Category (Part II). Vacancies , if any, further reported will also be divided in the above proportion between Part I and Part II in continuation of the division already made and candidates will be advised. The first turn of vacancies will be filled up for general category.

(2) A common ranked list will be prepared for the Vacancies under General Category (Part I) and Society Category (Part -II). Candidates will be advised against the vacancies reported for the above post strictly in accordance with the order of the receipt of vacancies in the office of the Commission and in accordance with rules of reservation and rotation followed by the Commission.

(3) The ranked list prepared and published by the Commission for the post shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list is published after the expiry of the minimum period of one year. Candidates will be advised for appointment against the aforesaid vacancies and also against the vacancies which are earmarked for the General Category during the period of currency of the list.

(4) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a statewide basis.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment.

6. Age Limit : Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years of age and must not have completed 37 (Thirty seven) years of age as on 01.01.2010 with usual relaxations to SC/ST/Backward communities as per rules.

Note:- In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (fifty) years. (For conditions regarding the age relaxation please see part (2) of the General Conditions)

For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under part II of this Notification. Relaxation of age will be allowed to all provisional employees of the twenty nine Co-operative institutions mentioned in G.O.(P)No.41/98 dated, 09.03.1998 (whether they continue in service or relieved from service) who have been appointed through the Employment Exchange to the extent of their provisional service provided they possess a minimum service of one year in the provisional appointment. The maximum period of relaxation allowed to such persons will be five years. Once they get appointment on regular basis, the concessions will not be available to further appointment to any post. The candidates who are entitled to the above concession shall note the details thereof in the respective columns of the applications and submit a certificate (original obtained from the Head of Office or Head of Department or appointing authority of the Co-operative Institutions concerned, when the Commission called for). The certificate should contain all the relevant particulars such as the post in which the applicant has/had provisional service, the scale of pay, name of the Co-operative Institution in which he/she has/had worked, the date of commencement of provisional service, and the date of termination of provisional service. It should also be noted in the certificate that the applicant is not holding regular appointment under the Co-operative Institutions. The original certificate thus produced will not be returned to the candidate.

7. Qualifications:-

1. Graduation from a recognised university with not less than 50% of marks in the aggregate; and Higher Diploma in Co-operation (HDC or HDC&BM of the State Co-operative union of Kerala or HDC and HDCM of National Council for Co-operative Training or successful completion of the subordinate (Junior) Personal Co-operative Training Course (Junior). Diploma in Co-operation.

OR

B.Sc (Co-operation with Banking) of Kerala Agricultural University.

2. MBA/CA/CWA/M.Com/M.Sc (Co-operation and Banking) of Kerala Agricultural University will be preferential qualification.

8. Mode of sending application:

The applications can be submitted by On-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. The applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the Website will be summarily rejected.
