The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked to the above communities, but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the ranked lists, published for the posts with effect from 16.01.2008, 09.07.2004 and 17.06.2004 respectively.

5. Method of appointment: Direct Recruitment. (from Candidates belonging to reservation groups mentioned in this notification. But application of Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered in the absence of SC candidates).

**NOTE:** Application of candidates belonging to other than the communities mentioned in this notification will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be sent to them.

6. Age Limit: Must have completed 20 (Twenty) years and must not have completed 42 (Forty Two) years of age for Ezhava, LC, OBC and Viswakarma and 44 (Forty four) years of age for SC and ST Communities as on 01.01.2010 (including relaxation in Para 2(i) of General Conditions. (For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see Para (2) of the General Conditions except Para 2(i)).

7. Qualifications:  
(Common for the three posts)

1. Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any Universities in Kerala.

2. (i) B.Ed. in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala.

(ii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed. degree acquired in the concerned Faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.

(iii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree as specified in items (i) and (ii) above, persons with B.Ed. degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.

3. Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the Agency authorized by the State Government.

NOTE: (1) In the absence of B.Ed.Degree holders, candidates having Masters Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D Degree or M.Phil Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed. Degree at their own expense within 5 years from the date of entry in service.

(2) Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed qualification.

(3) Persons who have acquired M.Ed. in the subject concerned recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed. qualification.

EXEMPTIONS: (Common for the three posts)

1. Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
2. Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
3. Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed. Degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
4. The teachers who have completed ten years of approved teaching service at the High School level in General Education Subordinate Service shall be exempted from passing the state Eligibility Test.

8. Mode of Submitting Applications

The applications can be submitted only by on-line facility provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application forms shall be quoted into all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
