Note: - (1) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.

(2) Separate Ranked List will be prepared for each district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked Lists thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in the following districts

(3) Applications should not be sent to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are sent contrary to the above direction, and if he/she is selected, his/her name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her. Reservation community candidates should submit application for this post to the concerned district officer where the vacancy is existing for their respective community. The address to which the applications are to be sent is furnished in column (10) of the notification.

(4) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (Ms.) No. 154/71/PD., dated 27-5-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O. (Ms.) No. 4/61/PD., dated 2-1-1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of Appointment: Direct Recruitment. (Candidates from Scheduled Tribe, Latin Catholic & SIUC N/AI communities only)

Note: - In the absence of ST candidates SC will also be considered.

6. Age limit: Should have completed 18 (eighteen) years of age and should not have completed 40 (forty) years of age for Scheduled Tribe candidates and 38 (Thirty Eight) years of age for candidates belonging to other communities as on 01.01.2010.

Note: - Including the relaxation as per para 2 (i) of General conditions.

For candidates regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the general conditions except para 2(1)

7. Qualifications:

1. General: PDC or equivalent qualification.
2. Special: A. Pass in General nursing and midwifery course of not less than 3 years.

B. Certificate of Registration with the Nurses and Midwives Council of any state in India as Nurse and Midwife in the case of women candidates and as Nurse in the case of male candidates.

Note: - (1) Those who have passed SSLC or equivalent qualification and those who possess the special qualification as per the old syllabi and undergone the Nursing and Midwife's Course of not less than 3^{1/2} years duration and possessing the qualification under item (2) B above obtained prior to 25.9.1996 will also be eligible for appointment to the post.

8. Application Form

The applications can be submitted only through On-line facility only provided in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the Website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community etc., have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
