- (i) In the absence of Scheduled Caste candidates Scheduled Tribe candidates will also be considered.
 - (ii) Conventional type application for the above post will be summarily rejected. Candidates can apply through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website viz. www.keralapsc.org
 - (iii) Application submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
 - (iv) Ranked list will be prepared for Malappuram district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked lists thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in following districts.

- (v) The candidates belonging to above reservation communities shall submit application for this post to Malappuram district where the vacancy is in existence for their community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application.
- (vi) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No.154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the same post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to above reservation communities only)

6. Age : **For Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates:18-40**

Only SC/ST candidates born between 2.1.1971 and 1.1.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post.

For Muslim candidates:- 18-38

Only Muslim, candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for the post. (Including the relaxation as per para 2(i) of General conditions).

Note: For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para 2 of General condition under part II of this notification (except para 2(i)).

7. Qualifications:

- (1) Pass in SSLC or equivalent qualification
- (2) Pass in Ayurveda Therapists Course conducted by Government of Kerala.

8. Last date of receipt of applications: 14.12.2011 Wednesday upto 12 midnight

9. Mode of submitting applications:-

Candidates shall submit the application with a Photo uploaded online. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of application are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The candidates applying on-line shall keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the bar code number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age, community etc. have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

10. If a Written Test/OMR Test is conducted as a part of the selection Admission Tickets of eligible candidates will be made available in the website of Kerala Public Service commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Admission tickets as per the instructions given in the website.

11. At the time of Examination, practical test, interview etc. candidates shall produce their photo affixed ID proof in original (Voters identity Card, Driving License, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare department to physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed pass book issued by a nationalised bank, PAN card, Identity Cards issued to Government employees by the concerned departments) and its self attested photocopy along with Hall Tickets.
