**FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION**

Applications with latest photo uploaded are invited online only from qualified Physically Handicapped candidates belonging to partially blind category in the state of Kerala against the vacancies reserved for them for the following post.

1. Department : Education
2. Name of post : Part Time Junior Language Teacher (Sanskrit)
3. Scale of pay : Rs. 5250-8390(PR)
4. No. of vacancies : District wise  
Kollam- Physically Handicapped  
(Partially Blind) – 1 (one)

**Note:-** (i) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website [www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org).

(ii) Applications submitted by candidates other than those belonging to Physically Handicapped (partially Blind) will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.

(iii) A Ranked list will be prepared for Kollam district in pursuance of this notification.

Ranked list thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the Physically Handicapped persons (Partially Blind) turns identified as unfilled, during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

(iv) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(MS) No.154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subjected to the rules in GO(MS)No. 4/61/PD dated, 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment [from among physically Handicapped (Partially Blind) candidates only].

6. Age : 1) 18-39. Only candidates born between 02.01.1972 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual age relaxation to Scheduled castes/ Scheduled Tribes / other backward class communities.

Note:- For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the general conditions.

7. Qualifications:

(1) SSLC OR Equivalent

(2) A degree in Sanskrit conferred or recognised by the any one of universities in Kerala.

OR

A Title of Oriental Learning in Sanskrit awarded or recognised by the Universities in Kerala.

OR

Oriental School Leaving Certificate (Sanskrit) issued by the Government Of Kerala.

OR

A pass in the Preliminary Examination in Sanskrit Conductor by any of the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A pass in Pre-University or Pre-Degree Examination from Sanskrit Colleges affiliated to the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A pass in Sanskrit Teachers Examination conducted by the commissioner for Government Examination, Kerala.

OR

A pass in Pre-Degree Examination with Sanskrit(Sahithya) and Sanskrit(Sastra) as Optional subject Conducted by the Arts or Science Coll

8. SPECIAL CONCESSIONS REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND AGE LIMIT

(i) Preference will be given laid down in G.O.(MS)No. 50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O(MS)No.9/78/G. Edn. Dated 21.01.78 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans, wives of Jawans must select “ Are you entitled to any priority as 'Yes' on On-line application and give the details in the following space.(Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the Officer commanding stating the name,Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same asand when required by the commission (GO(MS) No.509/64/Edn.dated 19.9.1964, G.O.(MS) No.614/65/Edn,dated 09.11.1965 and G.O. (MS) No.243/66/Edn.Dated 27.5.66)

(ii)First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O(MS) No. 122/75/G. Edn. Dated 27.05.1975 and G.O(MS)No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970).

(iii) Teachers of the Government Primary and Nursery Schools who are graduates and are otherwise qualified will be exempted from upper age limit (G.O(MS)No.185/70/Edn dated 18.04.1970 and G.O(MS)No. 466/70/Edn dated 11.11.1970). They should produce proper Certificates from authorities concerned.

Note:- The candidates who claim concessions by virtue of any of the above reason should state “Are you eligible for age relaxation as “Yes” on the online application and give details in the space following.

9. Last date for receipt of applications : 14.12..2011 Wednesday upto 12.00 midnight

10 The applications with latest photo uploaded shall be submitted online only to the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [Www.keralapsc.org](http://www.keralapsc.org). No application fee is required. The candidates applying through on-line should keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age and community etc have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

12. If a written test/OMR Test is conducted as a part of the selection Admission Tickets of eligible candidates will be made available on the website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their Admission Tickets as per the instructions given in the website.

At the time of Examination, Physical Efficiency Test, Practical Test, Interview etc, Candidates shall produce their Photo affixed ID proof in Original and self attested photocopy of (Voters Identity Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Identity Cards issued by Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Kerala, to Physically Handicapped Candidates, Photo affixed Pass Books issued by Nationalized Banks, PAN Card, Identity Cards issued to Government Employees by the concerned Departments) along with Hall Tickets.
