Applications with photo uploaded are invited online only from qualified candidates belonging to reservation group of community of Kerala State viz. SIUC Nadar/Anglo Indian for the under mentioned post.

- 1 **Department** : Education
- 2 **Name of post** : High School Assistant (Kannada)
- 3 **Scale of pay** : ₹ 14620-25280/-
- 4 **Number of vacancies** : District wise
Kasaragod - SIUC Nadar/Anglo Indian-1(One).

(IInd Re-notification of the post notified as Cat.No.41/2010 in Gazette dated, 27/02/2010)

NOTE:-

- (i) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply only through on-line application available with the Kerala Public Service Commission website www.keralapsc.org
- (ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.
- (iii) Seperate Ranked list will be prepared for Kasaragod district in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

(iv) Reservation community candidates should submit application for the post to the Kasaragod district only where the vacancy is existing for their respective community and note the name of that district against the relevant coloumn of the application. If applications are submitted contrary to the above direction and if he/she selected, his/her name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.

(v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO (Ms) No.154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO (MS) No. 4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

- 5 **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to SIUC Nadar/Anglo Indian community only)
- 6 **Age** : 18-42. Only candidates born between 02.01.1969 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including the age relaxation as per para 2(i) of General Conditions)

Note:- For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years. Please see Para (2) except Para 2(i) of the General Conditions under part II of this notification.

7. Qualifications : -

A degree in Kannada and B.Ed/B.T/L.T conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala.

OR

A Title of Oriental Learning in Kannada awarded or recognized by the Universities in Kerala (if such title has been declared as equivalent to part III of degree) and certificate in Language Teacher's Training issued by the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Kerala.

- Note:-** (i) Post Graduates in Kannada are also eligible to apply for this post provided they have B.Ed/B.T/L.T qualification.
- (ii) B.Ed should be in the Concerned subject ie, Kannada
- (iii) Disciplines in which B.A/M.A and B.Ed Degrees were obtained should be mentioned
- (iv) Those Candidates who secured B.Ed/B.T Degrees from the Universities outside Kerala should note in the application form, the number and date of relevant orders declaring the said degree as equivalent to those prescribed for this selection.

8. SPECIAL CONCESSIONS REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND AGE LIMIT

- (i) Preference will be given as laid down in G.O.(MS) No.50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and G.O.(MS) No.9/78/G.Edn. Dated 21.01.1978 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans Wives of Jawans should note in the application that they are wives of Jawans. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the Officer commanding stating the name, military rank and military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission (G.O.(MS) No. 509/64/Edn. Dated 19.09.1964, G.O. (MS) No. 614/65/Edn. Dated 09.11.1965 and G.O.(MS) No.243/66/Edn. Dated 27.05.1966).
- (ii) First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O. (MS) No.122/75/G.Edn. Dated 27.05.1975 and G.O.(MS) No. 50/70/PD dated 12/02/1970)
- (iii) Teachers of the Government Primary and Nursery Schools who are graduate and are otherwise qualified will be exempted from upper age limit [G.O.(MS) No. 185/70/Edn. Dated 18/04/1970 and G.O.(MS) No. 466/70/Edn. Dated 11/11/1970]. They should produce proper certificates from authorities concerned as and when required by the Commission.

Note:- The candidates who claim concessions in lieu of any of the above reason should state "Are you eligible for age relaxation" as "yes" on the online application and give details in the space following. Otherwise the applications are liable to be

rejected presuming that they are over aged candidates.

9. Mode of sending applications :-

The applications with photo uploaded shall be submitted online only to the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org . Photograph taken within six months should be uploaded. No application fee is required. The candidates applying through on-line should keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age and community etc have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

10. Last date for receipt of Applications : 04/01/2012 Wednesday upto 12 midnight.

11. If a written test/OMR test is conducted as a part of the selection Admission Tickets of eligible candidates will be made available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission. Candidates are advised to download their Admission Tickets as per the instructions given in the website.
