Note:- (i) Conventional type applications will be summarily rejected. Candidates shall apply online only to www.keralapsc.org.

- (ii) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.
- (iii) Separate Ranked list will be prepared for Kasargod districts in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published as per this notification shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following district.

- (iv) Reservation community candidates should submit application for the post to the concerned District Officer where the vacancy is existing for their respective communities and should note the name of that District against the relevant column in on-line application. Applications should not be submitted to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are submitted contrary to the above direction and if he/she is selected his/her name will be removed from the Rank List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.
- (v) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS) No.4/61/PD dated, 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, OX and Hindu Nadar Communities only) (In the absence of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe communities, candidates belonging to scheduled caste will be considered and vice versa)

6. Age : (1) 18-42. Only candidates born between 02.01.1969 and 01.01.1993 (Both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post in the case of OX and Hindu Nadar.
- (2) 18-44 .Only candidates born between 02.01.1967 and 01.01.1993 (Both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post in the case of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe.
- (3) The adult members converted from Scheduled Caste to Christianity and their children are eligible for age relaxation upto 44 years. Such candidate should be born between 02.01.1967 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) [Including the relaxation as per Para 2(i) of General Conditions].

Note:- For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the general conditions, except para 2(i)

7. Qualifications:

A Bachelors Degree or Post Graduate Degree with Mathematics or Statistics as Main Subject and B.Ed/B.T in the concerned subject both conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala.

- Note:-**
- (i) Diploma in Rural Service awarded by the National Council for Rural Higher Education will also be treated as equivalent to Degree for the above purpose.
 - (ii) The applicants should have taken Mathematics or Statistics as main subject for Graduation. Graduates with Physics as Main and Mathematics as subsidiary and teaching of Mathematics as one of the subjects for B.Ed. can also apply. Their applications will be considered only in the absence of Graduates in Mathematics/Statistics.
 - (iii) Question papers for the written test if any will be in Malayalam. The candidates should answer the question in Malayalam.
 - (iv) The disciplines in which B.Sc/M.Sc and B.Ed Degree were obtained should be mentioned in the brackets in the application form.
 - (v) Those candidates who secured B.Ed/B.T Degree from the Universities outside Kerala should note in the application form the number and date of relevant orders declaring the said degree as equivalent to those prescribed for this selection. The copies of such order shall be produced before the commission when it is called for.

8. SPECIAL CONCESSIONS REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND AGE LIMIT

(i) Preference will be given as laid down in G.O.(MS) No.50/70/PD dated 12.2.70 and G.O. (MS)No.9/78/G.Edn.dated 21.1.78 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base establishment are included under the terms of Jawans, Wives of Jawans must select "Are you entitled to any priority" as "Yes" on on-line application and give the details in the following space. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the Officer commanding stating the name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission (G.O.(MS) No. 509/64/Edn. Dated 19.9.1964, G.O.(MS) No. 614/65/Edn. Dated 09.11.65 and G.O.(MS) No.243/ 66/Edn. Dated 27.5.66).

(ii) First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers (G.O.(MS) No.122/75/G.Edn. dated 27.05.1975 and GO(MS) No. 50/70/PD dated 12/02/1970)

(iii) Teachers of the Government Primary and Nursery Schools who are graduates and are otherwise qualified will be exempted from upper age limit. [G.O (Ms) No. 185/70/Edn. Dated 18/04/1970 and G.O (Ms) No. 466/70/Edn. Dated 11/11/1970]. They should produce proper certificates from authorities concerned as and when required by the commission.

Note:- The candidates who claim concessions by virtue of any of the above reason should state "Are you eligible for age relaxation" as "yes" on the online application and give details in the space following.

9. Last date for receipt of applications : 01.02.2012 Wednesday upto 12 midnight

10. The applications with latest photo uploaded shall be submitted on-line only to the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org No application fee is required. The candidates applying on-line should keep the print out (Receipt) of their applications and the barcode number shall be quoted in all further enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualifications, age and community etc have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.
