FIRST N.C.A. NOTIFICATION

Applications with photograph uploaded are invited online only from qualified candidates belonging to reservation group of Dheevara Community in Kerala State for selection to the following post.

- 1 Name of firm** : Various Govt. Owned Companies/Corporations/Boards
- 2 Name of Post** : Driver Grade II/Driver (HDV)
- 3 Scale of Pay** : Scale of pay as prescribed for the post by the concerned Company/Corporation/Board
- 4 Number of vacancies** : Dheevara -1 (One)

Note:- (I) The above vacancy is now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the above vacancy only earmarked to the Dheevara community, but remaining unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of ranked list published on 28.02.2007 and cancelled w.e.f. 30.04.2010 based on the notification published in the Gazette dated 04.11.2003 (Cat.No: 140/2003)

(ii) The Kerala Public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidate to the above post, if it is subsequently found that such advice was made under some mistakes. On such cancellation the appointing authority shall terminate the service of the candidate, provided that, the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the appointing authority shall be made within the period of probation or 240 days from the date of joining duty whichever is earlier.

- 5 Method of Appointment** : Direct Recruitment (From among candidates belonging to reservation group of Dheevara Community in Kerala State)

Note:- Applications submitted by candidates other than those belonging to Dheevara Community will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be issued to such candidates.

6. Age : 18-38. Only candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. (Including relaxation in para 2 (i) of General conditions)

Note:- The provisional hands working in the various Companies/Corporations/Boards will be given age relaxation to the extent of their provisional service put in subject to a maximum of Five years from the upper age limit provided they are within the prescribed age limit on the date of their first appointment in the above concern. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional hands should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and

shall produce the same as and when required by the commission. It would also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of concern. The over aged candidates who become eligible to be included in the ranked list on the basis of their provisional service in any Company/Corporations/Board will be considered only in the vacancies reported by the same Company/Corporation/Board in which they have worked provisionally.

7. Qualifications:

- (1) Pass in Standard VII (New) or equivalent.
- (2) Current Motor Driving Licence Endorsed to drive Heavy Duty Vehicles with endorsement for Heavy Passenger Vehicles and Heavy Goods Vehicles and should have completed three years after obtaining the Heavy Duty Vehicle Licence. Heavy Duty Driving Licence issued after 16.01.1979 must have endorsement both for Heavy Goods and Heavy Passenger Vehicles and the applications of candidates possessing Licence with only one endorsement will be summarily rejected.
- (3) Normal visual standards as per MV Act and rules, and medical fitness as per prescribed standards.
- (4) Medical Fitness:
 - (a) Ear:- Hearing should be perfect
 - (b) Eye:- Distant vision- Right eye-6/6 snellen. Left eye- 6/6 snellen.
Near vision- Right eye 0.5 snellen Left eye- 0.5 snellen
Colour vision- Normal
Night blindness- Nil
 - (c) Muscles and Joints- No Paralysis and all joints with free movements.
 - (d) Nervous System-Perfectly normal and free from any infectious diseases.

Note:-

- 1) The Medical Certificate (in original) issued in the prescribed form by a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Asst. Surgeon regarding the physical fitness and a Medical Certificate regarding vision from an ophthalmologist in Govt. Service in the prescribed format must be produced as and when called for by the Commission. The prescribed forms of medical certificates are given below.
- 2) Physically handicapped persons are not eligible to apply for this post.
- 3) Candidates should possess current Driving Licence on the last date for receipt of applications in this Office and also on the date of Practical Test/Interview.
- 4) The proficiency to drive Heavy Duty Vehicles will be assessed by conducting a practical test.

8. Mode of sending Applications:

Applications with photograph uploaded shall be submitted online only. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondences. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

Specification for each eye should be stated separately. Special attention should be directed to the distant vision. Required standards of vision are as follows.

(c) Each eye must have full field of vision.
