- i. Conventional type applications for the above post will be summarily rejected. Candidates can apply through online application available at the Kerala Public Service Commission website www.keralapsc.org.
 - ii. Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than those notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued to these candidates.
 - iii. Separate Ranked List will be prepared for above District in pursuance of this notification. Ranked List thus prepared and published by the Commission shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above community, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post in the following dates in following districts.

- iv. The candidates belonging to above reservation community (Viz.Dheevera) shall submit application for this post to the Thiruvananthapuram district where the vacancy is in existence for their community and shall note the name of that district against the relevant column in the online application.
 - v. The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he/she complete five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in former district. Even if transfer is allowed after 5 years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS) No.4/61/PD dated, 2.1.1961. The candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (From candidates belonging to Dheevera community only)
 6. Age : 18-38. Only Dheevera candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply

for this post.Ex-Servicemen are eligible for usual age relaxation.

- Note:-** (1) For concessions allowed in the upper age limit in the case of Ex-Service man, please see para 2(vi) of general conditions under part II of this notification
(2) For concessions allowed in upper age limit, subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 years, please see para (2) of the General Conditions under part II of this notification

7. Qualifications:

- 1) Must be a pensioned Junior Commissioned Officer of the Army or equivalent in the Navy or Air Force.

OR

- In the absence of candidates with qualifications mentioned in item (I) above, candidates with literacy in
(2) English and ten years Military Service in the Army, Navy or Air Force.

OR

- In the absence of qualified hands under item(1) and (2) above, SSLC or equivalent with six months
(3) Police or Military Training.

Note:-1. A working knowledge in Malayalam, Tamil or Kannada shall be an essential qualification.

2. Physically Handicaped candidates shall not be eligible to apply for the post. Hence sub para (vii) on para (2) and para 5 of the General Conditions are not applicable to this post.
3. The candidate shall produce a Medical Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon Grade II to prove the following physical Qualification at the time of interview.

- a) I) Height -167 cms
II) Chest -81 cms with a minimum expansion of 5 cms.
b) Visual standards with Glasses:

Each eye must have full field of vision. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or eyelid of either eye shall be a disqualification.

- c) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins, bow legs, deformed limbs, irregular and protruding teeth, defective speech and hearing.
