Applications with photo uploaded are invited online only from qualified Scheduled Tribe candidates of Kerala State for selection to the following post.

1. Department : Various
2. Name of post : Attender (Special Recruitment for Scheduled Tribes only)
3. Scale of pay : ₹ 8,730 – 13,540/-
4. No. of vacancies : District wise

Wayanad - 1 (One)

Note:- 1) This list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancy and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Tribes during the pendency of the list.

2) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a Revenue District basis subject to the Special Conditions laid down in G.O.(MS) No.154/71/PD, dated 27-05-1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one Revenue District from the Ranked List so prepared is not eligible for transfer to another District unless he/she completes five (5) years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former District. Even if, transfer is allowed after five (5) years, it will be subject to the orders contained in G.O.(MS) No.4/61/PD, dated 02-01-1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding the post in one District are restricted from applying for the same post in another District. But they can apply for higher posts.

3) Candidates from the Ranked List will be advised for appointment against the Headquarters vacancies also. As per the provision in G.O.(MS) No.154/71/PD, dated 27-05-1971, appointment against the Headquarter vacancies will be started from Thiruvananthapuram District. Separate option not be given for this.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (Special Recruitment from among Scheduled Tribes only).

Note:- Applications received from non Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6. Age Limit : 18 – 40 (Only candidates born between 02.01.1971 and 01.01.1993 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.

Note:- In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 50 years. But in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7 Qualifications

Pass in Standard VII (New) or equivalent qualification.

Probation :- Every person appointed to the post shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

Test :- Every person appointed to the post shall during the period of probation pass the Attenders Test conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission.

8. Method of Submitting Application :-

The applications can be submitted On-line only. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all enquiries/correspondence. The applications which are not submitted in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

Note :- Documents to prove Qualification, Age, Community etc, have to be produced as and when called for.

9. Last date for receipt of applications : 08/02/2012 Wednesday, upto 12:00 Midnight.

11. Paragraphs two, three and twenty five (except the conditions laid down in the Rule 3 (c) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules) of the General Conditions are not applicable to this selection.

12. Appointments are made subject to the rank secured in the Ranked List of candidates prepared in pursuance of this notification subject to the conditions laid down in G.O.(P) No.21/76/PD dated 17/01/1976 and G.O.(P) No. 25/94/GAD dated, 22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled Tribes and in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under sections 3 (c), 17 (a), 17(b) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.

13. If a written Test/OMR test is conducted as part of the selection, hall ticket of eligible candidates will be made available on the website of the Kerala public Service Commission. Candidates are instructed to download their hall ticket as per the instructions on the website.
